High peanut sales in the Brazilian domestic market



According to ABICAB, Brazilian Association of the Industry of Chocolate, Cocoa, Peanut, Candy and Derivatives, the month of June is the best for peanut sales and concentrates about 30% of the whole year. The typical parties of the period as well as the improvement of Brazilian income and the good harvest of 2012/2013, that according to data from the National Supply Company (Conab), reached 310,000 tons, keep industries excited about the high demand of the product for the remainder of year 2013.

Signed the law that creates FUNCAJU

On Friday, June 21, 2013, President Dilma Rousseff signed the law that will create from January 2014 on a fund (Funcaju) to support the culture of cashew and stimulate the development of this chain through Brazilian industry upgrade and renewal of trees. It is important to mention the importance of the cashew crop for some Northeastern States in Brazil and in recent years a conjuncture of factors, from prolonged drought to lost productivity, made Brazil invert its position importing the item instead of export it as it was in the past.

FCOJ: Season to start, not start



Orange new season is struggling against environmental conditions in an attempt to start.

In south of Brazil, for example, heavy rains had delayed it at least in about two weeks when, due to soil specific characteristics on that area that became a complete clay with excessive water, trucks cannot enter into the fields to collect the fresh fruit that, as known, don't keep waiting on the trees to be harvested. As already felt, Brazilian 2013 winter will be very wet.

In northeast of Brazil, lack of rains are still punishing the industry resulting in the lack of fruit and the one available gives a very poor yield when processing, increasing industrial costs.

In São Paulo area, situation seems to be under control until now, with particularly of a high ratio season being felt at the farms, that still fight for better prices of the fruit, lack of care for trees, greening attack, aggressive sugar cane competition and others, all making firm the prices' increases.
