Inauguration of new Coplana's unit



It's a great pleasure to inform that we have attended the inauguration of two more Coplana's unit in Jaboicabal, interior of the state of São Paulo.

Coplana is the largest Brazilian peanut processing company, and its cooperative has 12,500 hectares of peanut planted.

One unit will increase the current capacity of blanching and the other one will produce roasted peanuts - granulated or in halves - and later paste and flour.

Final Chinese tomato crop is not optimistic

The 2012 Chinese tomato crop has ended and complications increased and as per producers the final number of pulp produced should be 62% lower compared to 2011, this means no more than 40.000 tons of the product.

Furthermore, for HB 30/32° pulp there is virtually no availability of product from the 2012 crop, since due difficulties producers have chosen to produce CB 36/38°.

FCOJ: forecast



Despite doubts that reach the citrus market today, it's clear that there is pressure to reduce the fruit offer, equalizing the demand to maintain the prices firm and the citrus chain running smoothly.

During this crop about 60 million boxes of non-contracted fruit will not be harvested and farmers are selling this fruit to the fresh market as lower prices in order to avoid diseases at the fields, what is another concern, because nobody knows how much it will affect the numbers of the coming season – that is already supposed to be smaller, after two big last ones – once it is not possible to know if all the prevention working in the fields are being done accordingly, due to the low pricing farmers are being paid for the fruit.

Considering that industry have already about 55% of its needs of fruit from its own fields, there are two

possibilities to the farmers: whether to setup medium plants to process its own fruits, because today there is no industrial capacity available to crush this quantity or – as many have already done – change from citrus to sugar cane, considering the increase of Ethanol business and the guarantee of profit.

It is also worth commenting that last week the Brazilian Government intervened to extend the holding of the LEC FCOJ stock program.
